ORDINANCE NO. 1-06

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DISCHARGE INTO THE SEWER SYSTEM OF THE BOROUGH OF EAST BANGOR THE EFFLUENT FROM ANY SUMP PUMP OR ANY OTHER TYPE OF PUMP WHICH PUMPS STORM WATER, SURFACE WATER, GROUND WATER, ROOF RUN-OFF, SUBSURFACE DRAINAGE, BASEMENT DRAINAGE, UNCONTAMINATED COOLING WATER OR UNPOLLUTED INDUSTRIAL PROCESSED WATER, AS WELL AS PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE IN ANY OTHER FASHION OF SUCH WATERS INTO THE SEWER SYSTEM.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted, by the Council of the Borough of East Bangor, County of Northampton, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

A. Person - Any individual, partnership, co-partnership, firm, company, corporation, association, joint stock company, trust, estate, governmental entity or any other legal entity or their legal representatives, agents, successors or assigns. The masculine gender shall include the feminine and neuter, the singular shall include the plural where indicated by the context.

B. Sewer System - Sewage disposal system operated and owned by the East Bangor Municipal Authority (the "Authority"), including, but not limited to, any pipe or conduit conveying sanitary sewage and the treatment system treating said sanitary sewage.

C. Storm Water - That portion of the precipitation which runs off over the surface during a storm and for a short period following a storm enters the sewer system.

D. Surface Water - That portion of the precipitation which runs off over the surface of the ground.

SECTION 2.

A. All connections to the Sewer System which would result in the discharge of infiltration or inflow into such system are hereby specifically prohibited.

B. No Person shall discharge or cause to be discharged into the Sewer System any storm water, surface water, ground water, roof runoff, subsurface drainage, uncontaminated cooling water or unpolluted industrial process waters. Where existing surface water or roof drains are connected to the Sewer System, they shall be removed within ninety (90) days of receipt of a notice from the Authority to remove such connections. In the event such connection is not removed, the Authority shall cause such connection to be removed at the owner's expense.

C. No Person shall discharge or cause to be discharged into the Sewer System the effluent from any sump pump or any other type of pump which pumps any storm water, surface water, ground water, roof runoff, subsurface drainage, basement drainage, uncontaminated cooling water or unpolluted industrial process water, into any sanitary sewer. Where such conditions exist, they shall be remedied in a manner approved by the Authority within ninety (90) days of receipt of a notice from the Authority. In the event such conditions are not remedied, the Authority shall cause such condition to be remedied at the owner's expense.

SECTION 3. In all respects, any and all responsibility for the enforcement of this Ordinance No. 1-06 shall be vested and shall remain with the Authority unless changed by further Ordinance of the Borough of East Bangor.

SECTION 4. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Borough, and any persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance, upon conviction before any District Justice of Northampton County, shall be fined up to One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, plus costs. Each ninety (90) day period during which such violation of such provisions shall continue shall be deemed to be a separate offense.


SECTION 5. Any Ordinance, or part of any Ordinance, inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be repealed.


