ORDINANCE NO. 2-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF EAST BANGOR, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING, IN PART, ORDINANCE NO. 254, ENACTED SEPTEMBER 8, 1975, AND PROVIDING, INTER ALIA, FOR REMOVAL OF ANY AND ALL OBSTRUCTIONS ON SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE BOROUGH LIMITS.

Section 1: Section 2 of Ordinance No. 254, enacted September 8, 1975, shall be amended to read as follows:

Responsibility for Removal of Brush and Limbs and Tree Trimming. The owner, occupant or tenant of every property fronting upon or alongside any street in the Borough of East Bangor is hereby required to keep sidewalks in front of or alongside such property clear of brush and limbs, and to keep overhanging limbs trimmed so that they are at least eight (8) feet above such sidewalk. Failure to clear sidewalks of brush and limbs, and to keep overhanging limbs trimmed after notice to do so by Council within the time limit prescribed therein shall constitute a violation of this ordinance. Provided: the owner of a property shall be responsible for conforming to the requirements of this section where such property is occupied by such owner or unoccupied or is a multiple-unit property, having more than one tenantable unit; the tenant or occupier shall be responsible where the property is composed

of a single unit, occupied by such tenant or occupant only. PROVIDED, FURTHER, that the owner, occupant or tenant of every property fronting upon or alongside any street in the Borough of East Bangor, is hereby required to keep sidewalks free from all obstructions, impediments, barriers, or other items, which would restrict the movement of pedestrian traffic upon or along said sidewalks. This shall include, but shall not be limited to, construction materials, retail goods, vending machines, bicycles, strollers, boxes, cartons, pallets, skids, or debris. This shall not affect the owner, occupant or tenant from placing garbage and recyclables for weekly pickup by the Borough's contracted trash or recycling hauler, provided, however, that all provisions regarding the garbage collection ordinance, for this purpose, shall be strictly complied with.


Section 2: All other provisions of Ordinance No. 254, enacted September 8, 1975, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: Any ordinance or part of any ordinance inconsistent with this ordinance shall be repealed.


Section 4: This Ordinance shall be placed into effect immediately upon enactment.




